

NEA Baptist Cancer Screening Clinic

Early detection of cancer greatly increases the chances for successful treatment. There are two major components of early detection of cancer: education to promote early diagnosis and screening.

Screening tests are used to find cancer when there are no symptoms. Screenings give you the best chance of finding cancer as early as possible – while it's small and before it has spread.

The NEA Baptist Cancer Screening Clinic program* includes a 15 minute appointment and a questionnaire.

- **Prostate Cancer Screening** - Evaluation Required - Men will receive a PSA before the initial evaluation unless they have had one within one year.
- **Colorectal Cancer Screening** - Evaluation Required
- **Testicular Cancer Screening** - Evaluation Required
- **Lung Cancer Screening** - Those interested in the Lung Cancer Screening will need to meet a set of criteria prior to scheduling an appointment. Must meet specific set of criteria. Refer to back
- **Breast Cancer Screening** - Mammogram, if needed, will be provided at the NEA Baptist Breast Imaging Center
- **Hypertension** - All patients will be screened for hypertension

*Insurance is billed for services.

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Lung Cancer Screening Criteria

- Be 55-77 years of age
- Be asymptomatic (no signs or symptoms of lung cancer)
- Have a tobacco smoking history of at least 30 pack-years (one pack-year = smoking one pack per day for one year; 1 pack = 20 cigarettes)
- Be a current smoker or one who has quit smoking within the last 15 years
- Receive a written order for a lung cancer screening with LDCT (low dose CT scan) that meets the requirements described in the NCD
